Subject: TSCA Chemical Substance (EPA ruling Jan 6, 2021)

On January 6, 2021, the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) published the final rules under Section 6(h) of the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) for five Persistent, Bio-accumulative and Toxic (PBT) chemicals (see below table). It is to reduce the risk of exposure to humans and the environment. This rule will be effective from 5 February 2021, and ban five chemicals substances (and products that contain those substances) from being manufactured and sold in the U.S as of March 8, 2021.

We hereby confirm that printed circuit boards (PCBs) supplied by NCAB Group complies with the five chemical substances restrictions below:
